
I-751: Petition to Remove Conditions on Residence

Required Documents:

- Copy of Permanent Resident Card (front and back)
 - Include copy of Permanent Resident Card (front and back) for any conditional resident child included in petition
- Copy of *documents evidencing marriage was entered into in “good faith”* (submit as many as you can):
 - Birth certificates of children born to the marriage
 - Lease or mortgage contracts showing joint occupancy and/or ownership of your communal residence
 - Financial records showing joint ownership of assets and joint responsibility for liabilities
 - Examples: joint savings and checking accounts with transaction history, complete joint federal and state tax returns, insurance policies that show the other spouse as beneficiary, joint utility bills, or joint installment or other loans
 - Other documents to show your marriage was entered into in “good faith”
 - Affidavits sworn to or affirmed by *at least 2 people* who have known both of you since your conditional residence was granted and have personal knowledge of your marriage and relationship (*see [instructions](#)*)
- If you are a child filing separately from your parent:
 - Full explanation as to why you are filing separately
 - Copies of any supporting documentation
- Copy of criminal records, (if applicable)
- If you have had a legal name change, include the court order indicating the change
- If applicable*
 - An explanation for reason you are filing late;
 - An explanation for the reason you are filing separately from your primary conditional permanent resident parent;
 - Dispositions on criminal charges, arrests, or convictions; and
 - If you are filing from outside of the United States because you, your spouse, or your stepparent is residing outside of the United States on U.S. military or government orders:
 - Two passport-style photographs for each petitioner and dependent, regardless of age
 - Two completed Form FD- 258 Fingerprint Cards for each petitioner and dependent 14 to 79 years of age; and
 - A copy of current military or government orders.

Waivers to Joint Filing Requirements

Include the following evidence if you are filing to waive the joint filing requirements because:

1. **The *death* of your spouse:**
 - Copy of their death certificate
2. **Your marriage has been *terminated*:**
 - Copy of divorce decree or document evidencing termination or annulment
3. **You and/or your conditional resident child were battered or subject to extreme cruelty:**
 - Evidence of the abuse, examples include:
 - o Copies of reports or official records issued by police, courts, medical personnel, schools, clergy, social workers, and other social service agencies
 - o Copies of legal documents such as orders of protections
 - o Photographs evidencing your injuries
 - o Evidence you sought safe haven in a shelter
 - A copy of the divorce decree, if your marriage was terminated by divorce on grounds of physical abuse or extreme cruelty
4. **The termination of your status and removal would result in “*extreme hardship*”:**
 - Evidence that your removal would result in an extreme hardship based *only* on factors that arose since you became a conditional resident
