

# N-400: Application for Naturalization

### Fee:

\$725 (Filing fee \$640 and additional biometrics fee of \$85). You must make your check payable to Department of Homeland Security (do not use initials DHS or USDHS)

# Information to bring to fill out application

- Permanent Residence Card
- □ Your residence history for the last five years. Including the address and dates of residence.
- □ Your employment and/or school history for the last five years. Including employers address and dates of employment.
- □ Your travel history for the last five years, including the dates you departed and returned to the U.S.
- □ Date and location of any traffic tickets.
- □ Your spouse's full legal name, date of birth, Social Security number, alien number (A#) (if applicable), date and place of naturalization, and current address.
- □ Information about all your prior marriages and about all of your current spouse's prior marriages; including date of marriage, date the marriage ended, and how the marriage ended.
- □ If you have children, their full name, dates of birth, alien number (A#) (if applicable), and address.
- □ Documentation of all arrests and/or convictions, including reason for the arrest, date, place, and outcome/disposition. Bring ALL arrest and court documents, even if the charges were dropped

## **Required Documents**

- □ Copy of Permanent Resident Card (front and back)
- □ If any trips were taken outside of the US longer than 6 months since becoming a permanent resident, you must show evidence that all parties applying still continued to work, live and keep ties to the US
  - For example: IRS tax return; rent or mortgage payments and paystubs
- □ If applicable:
  - A copy of your marriage certificate
  - Form N-426, Request for Certification of Military or Naval Service (if applying for naturalization based on military service)
  - DD Form 214, NGB Form 22, or discharge orders (if applying for naturalization based on military service and separated from service)



- A copy of your official military orders (if applying for naturalization based on military service and currently serving)
- Evidence of your citizen spouse's employment abroad (if applying under 319(b))
- Two passport-style photographs (if you reside outside the United States)

# If you are applying on the basis of marriage to a US citizen, send the following four items

- □ Evidence that your spouse has been a citizen for 3 years
  - Birth certificate
  - Certificate of Naturalization
  - o Certificate of Citizenship; or
  - Inside of the front cover and signature page of spouse's current US passport
  - o Form FS-240, Report of Birth Abroad of a Citizen of the United States of America
- □ Current marriage certificate
- □ Proof of termination of all previous marriages of your spouse (if applicable)
- Documents referring to you and your spouse
  - Tax returns, leases/mortgages, birth certificates of children,
  - IRS certified copies of income tax forms that you both filed for the past three years or
  - An IRS tax return transcript for the last three years
